CME 45th Annual AMDAANA Conference: Updates in Internal Medicine and Cardiovascular Diseases

Outcome Objectives

- Implement evidence-based treatments for major depressive disorder (MDD); evaluate data and research for novel treatments of MDD.
- Identify valvular heart disease in early stages; implement anticoagulation post minimally-invasive valvular interventions.
- Diagnose peripheral arterial disease effectively and manage/treat from a primary care and specialist's perspective.
- Implement current options for anticoagulation and antiplatelet agents, or utilize alternative options for patients who can't be treated with anticoagulants.
- Titrate lipid-lowering therapies for specific populations using knowledge of LDL <55 mg/dL as the new target for VHR ASCVD.
- Counsel South Asian patients regarding their tendency to accumulate visceral fat even at lower BMI thresholds; implement alternative, non-BMI-based measurement metrics.
- Evaluate patients with osteoporosis, and counsel patients on nutritional needs to preserve and promote bone health.
