

Outcome Objectives

- > Implement evidence-based treatments for major depressive disorder (MDD); evaluate data and research for novel treatments of MDD.
- Identify valvular heart disease in early stages; implement anticoagulation post minimally-invasive valvular interventions.
- Diagnose peripheral arterial disease effectively and manage/treat from a primary care and specialist's perspective.

- Evaluate patients with osteoporosis, and counsel patients on nutritional needs to preserve and promote bone health.
